## Workshops:

### **New** Who Am I? Imaginative Drawing

Grades K-8 – Sarah Kang

In this engaging and creative self-portrait workshop, students will explore the art of capturing their own likeness through drawing. Upon booking, educators can choose from the following options:



- **My Future Self:** Students will imagine and draw how they see themselves in the future, encouraging reflection on their dreams and aspirations
- **In My Dreams:** Students create a self-portrait inspired by their dreams, blending reality and imagination
- **Picasso Style Self-Portrait:** Inspired by the bold and abstract style of Picasso, students will experiment with colour, shape, and form to create a self-portrait that challenges traditional representation

Each theme encourages students to explore their identity and express themselves through art, resulting in a self-portrait that is as unique as they are.

Grades K-5 – Gayle Hunter

Six Nations elder Gayle Hunter will visit your class and lead a 1.5-hour session, bringing rich traditions to life in the classroom. Through the magic of drama, kids get a chance to actively embody different characters in these traditional stories, learning important lessons through dialogue and discussion, and connecting with Indigenous culture in a meaningful way. It's an immersive experience weaving together education, creativity, and respect for the diverse traditions that shape our community. Join us for an engaging exploration of heritage and storytelling! Teachers

can choose between the following stories and lessons:

#### For Grades K-3:

Shi'gaag – Skunk

*Why Skunk has a Scent: Villagers confront Skunk who has been playing tricks on them*

Amik – Beaver

*Why Beaver has Sharp Teeth: The importance of helping each other*

E'si'bun – Raccoon

*Why Raccoon has a Mask: Why it's wrong to take things that don't belong to you*

Ma'ii'gun and Animoosh – Wolf & Dog

*The Race: How to believe in yourself and do your best*

Waboose – Rabbit

*How Rabbit got Long Ears: The importance of listening to rules about safety*

**For Grades 4-5:**

Ganaw – Frog

*Frog's pond is polluted and he needs help saving everyone from getting sick: How to be brave and ask for help from others*

Gaak – Raven

*Raven, who forgot to eat, has a hard time doing his work: The importance of taking care of yourself so you can take care of others*

Hoon – Salmon

*Salmon has natural medicine to share with everyone who got sick from the polluted pond: How to overcome shyness and communicate*
